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FORMAT: USEF/AVA rules apply with USEF rules superceding AVA when there is any conflict. Please review new USEF rules. All participating vaulters, longeurs, and coaches must be AVA members in good standing by the close of entries, April 20, 2017 or pay the AVA non-member fee before beginning competition. Signature of a coach registered with the club is required on page 4. All vaulters, longeurs, horse owners, coaches and trainers participating in USEF recognized classes must be USEF members in good standing or pay the \$30 USEF Show Pass fee. Vaulters not in compliance with current USEF/AVA requirements will forfeit any awards.

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the show management whose decision shall be final. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise. The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit entries and cancel award prizes without claims for damages; to cancel or combine unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. Show management reserves to itself the power to prohibit any person from attending or showing a horse in the ring and to remove any groom or horse from the show without being liable for compensation. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, bio-hazardous medical waste containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste. No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform. It is the tradition of the show that riders be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed and the horses properly presented. Management may in its discretion bar any person from entering the ring if not suitable presented to appear before an audience.

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

RELEASE FORMS: Each vaulter, parent for minor vaulter, coach, owner, groom, longeur (coach may sign for all) must sign on page 4 and all participants (parent for minor vaulters) must sign a Garrod Farms release form.

DEADLINE: ENTRIES ONLINE OR EMAILED (marianne@mariannerose.net) and PAYMENT/FORMS mailed no later than **midnight, April 20, 2017**, ENTRIES BY MAIL postmarked no later than **APRIL 17, 2017** to Marianne Rose, 11845 Skyline Blvd., Los Gatos, CA 95033. NO post entries allowed. Any mail requiring signature will be refused. Please review the current USEF and AVA rules. 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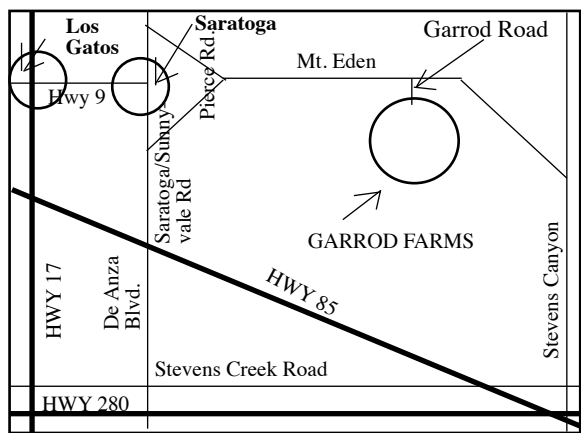

For more than 5 items, the charge will be \$2 per item. A \$5 mailing fee will be assessed to any club not picking up ALL their ribbons/scoresheets at Check-out.

Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
